

Hanyang English Film Festival 2016

Rules

1. Students who wish to submit films must **submit them here**, on the HEFF website.
2. Films should be from 4 to 6 minutes in length, including credits.
3. Films should be in English. (If they convey the story fully, English subtitles are okay.)
4. Use the MP4 file format for final film submissions. (Conversion software is available.)
5. Any music used in the films should be licensed under creative commons / royalty free.
6. No documentaries, parodies or promotional films. All films should tell a story and be original work.
7. Respect for the conservative values of the HYU university community is highly recommended. Therefore, use common sense with profanity, nudity and/or sexually suggestive content.
8. **A silver HYU lion** should appear at least once in the film. There are several of these sculptures located throughout the Seoul campus. This lion may not appear only in the title sequence or closing credits.
